Answer Key 2D Shapes — Easy

1. Triangle

Count the sides and corners. A shape with 3 sides and 3 corners is a triangle.

2. Square

A square has 4 equal sides and 4 right angles.

3. Circle

A circle is perfectly round with no corners or flat sides.

4. Rectangle

A rectangle has 4 sides; opposite sides are equal. Unlike a square, not all sides are equal.

5. 6

Hex- means 6. A hexagon has 6 sides.

6. 3

A triangle has 3 sides and 3 corners (also called vertices).

7. Rectangle

A rectangle has 4 right angles but the sides are not all equal (opposite sides are equal).

8. Sphere

A ball is a sphere — a perfectly round 3D shape.

9. 5

Penta- means 5. A pentagon has 5 sides.

10. Circle

A circle has no straight sides and no corners.
