Answer Key

Addition & Subtraction — Easy

1. 8

Count on from 3: 4, 5, 6, 7, 8. Or use the fact: $3 + 5 = 8$.

2. 9

Start at 7, count on 2: 8, 9.

3. 8

$4 + 4$ is a doubles fact: $4 + 4 = 8$.

4. 9

Start at 6, count on 3: 7, 8, 9.

5. 10

$5 + 5$ is a doubles fact: $5 + 5 = 10$.

6. 9

One more than 8 is 9.

7. 9

Start at 7 (the larger number) and count on 2: 8, 9.

8. 6

Adding 0 to any number gives that same number: $0 + 6 = 6$.

9. 10

$9 + 1 = 10$ is a make-ten fact.

10. 6

$3 + 3$ is a doubles fact: $3 + 3 = 6$.
