Counting Objects — Easy

1. 7

Count each star one at a time: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7.

2. 5

Count each apple: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.

3. 7

Count all crayons together: 1, 2, 3 (red), 4, 5, 6, 7 (blue) = 7.

4. 6

One group of 5 (4 vertical + 1 diagonal) + 1 extra = 6.

5. 6

Start at 8 and count back 2: $8 \rightarrow 7 \rightarrow 6$. There are 6 dogs left.

6. 9

Count each circle one at a time to get 9.

7. 7

The number that comes after 6 is 7. Count up: ...5, 6, 7.

8. 9

The number before 10 is 9. Count: ...8, 9, 10.

9. 3

Count each mark: 3 individual vertical marks = 3.

10. 7

Start at 4 and count on 3 more: 5, 6, 7. Sam has 7 books.
