Answer Key

Time & Elapsed Time — Easy

1. 3:00 PM

2:00 PM + 1 hour = 3:00 PM.

2. 6:00 PM

4:00 PM + 2 hours = 6:00 PM.

3. 2:00 PM

8:00 AM + 6 hours = 2:00 PM (crosses noon at 12:00).

4. 12:00 PM

11:30 AM + 30 minutes = 12:00 PM (noon).

5. 5:00 PM

3:00 PM + 2 hours = 5:00 PM.

6. 10 hours

8:00 PM to 12:00 AM = 4 hours. 12:00 AM to 6:00 AM = 6 hours. Total: $4 + 6 = 10$ hours.

7. 30 minutes

From 3:00 to 3:30 is 30 minutes.

8. 15 minutes

From 9:00 to 9:15 is 15 minutes.

9. 2:30

$2:00 + 30 \text{ minutes} = 2:30$.

10. 4 hours

$8:00 \rightarrow 9:00 \rightarrow 10:00 \rightarrow 11:00 \rightarrow 12:00 = 4 \text{ hours}$.
