Answer Key

Multiplication & Division — Easy

1. **12**

Think of 3 groups of 4: 4, 8, 12. Or use the fact: $3 \times 4 = 12$.

2. **30**

Count by 5s six times: 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30.

3. **18**

Double 9: $9 + 9 = 18$.

4. **28**

4 groups of 7: 7, 14, 21, 28.

5. **9**

3×3 is a square number: $3 \times 3 = 9$.

6. **25**

5×5 is a square number: $5 \times 5 = 25$.

7. **16**

Double 8: $8 + 8 = 16$.

8. **16**

4×4 is a square number: $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 16$.

9. **15**

3 groups of 5: $5 + 5 + 5 = 15$. Or $3 \times 5 = 15$.

10. **24**

$4 \times 6 = 24$. Count by 6s: 6, 12, 18, 24.
