$$5 \times \$0.30 = \$1.50. \text{ Change: } \$2.00 - \$1.50 = \$0.50.$$

2. **\$7.70**

$$\$6.45 + \$1.25 = \$7.70.$$

3. **\$2.60**

$$4 \times \$0.65 = \$2.60.$$

4. **\$2.65**

$$\$5.00 - \$2.35 = \$2.65.$$

5. **\$3.55**

$$\$7.00 - \$3.45 = \$3.55.$$

6. **\$9.60**

$$2 \times \$4.80 = \$9.60.$$

7. **\$3.24**

$$\$3.49 - \$0.25 = \$3.24.$$

8. **\$9.00**

$$6 \times \$1.50 = \$9.00.$$

9. **\$1.25**

$$\$10.00 - \$8.75 = \$1.25.$$
