Answer Key

Order of Operations — Easy

1. **11**

Multiply first: $4 \times 2 = 8$. Then add: $3 + 8 = 11$.

2. **4**

Multiply first: $2 \times 3 = 6$. Then subtract: $10 - 6 = 4$.

3. **19**

Multiply first: $5 \times 3 = 15$. Then add: $15 + 4 = 19$.

4. **11**

Divide first: $6 \div 2 = 3$. Then add: $8 + 3 = 11$.

5. **2**

Divide first: $20 \div 4 = 5$. Then subtract: $5 - 3 = 2$.

6. **13**

Multiply first: $3 \times 4 = 12$. Then left to right: $2 + 12 - 1 = 13$.

7. **13**

Division and multiplication first: $15 \div 3 = 5$, $2 \times 4 = 8$. Then add: $5 + 8 = 13$.

8. **2**

Both multiplications first: $7 \times 2 = 14$, $3 \times 4 = 12$. Then subtract: $14 - 12 = 2$.

9. **13**

Divide first: $12 \div 3 = 4$. Then add: $9 + 4 = 13$.

10. **16**

Left to right for $\times$ and $\div$: $6 \times 5 = 30$, $30 \div 2 = 15$. Then add: $15 + 1 = 16$.
